

The Children's Dental Clinic (CDC) opened its doors in 1946 and this year begins celebrating its 68th year of dental care for children in the Tredyffrin/Easttown and Great Valley School Districts!

The CDC is a nonprofit, 501 (c) (3) charitable organization, registered with the Pennsylvania Bureau of Charitable Organizations, supported by community fund-raising events, donations from local dentists, residents, service organizations, PTO's, and the two school districts.

Student eligibility is based on the criteria used by the two school districts for the free and reduced lunch program.

Students who come to The CDC receive preventative dental care as well as extensive restorative work of their teeth; all records are kept confidential, with the students' families asked to pay a nominal fee of \$5.00 per visit.

Most treatment is completed "in house" with specialist services used in the cases where endodontic or orthodontic services are needed.

Volunteers are the backbone of this organization and are needed to transport students to The CDC located in the T/E Middle School.
